Indicators are manageable bits of data that provide some aspect of well-being

- Encourage democratic participation in visioning a community's goals
 - Measure progress toward achievement of those goals
 - Raise awareness & focus attention on community priorities
 - Actively choose future desired outcomes



State of the Basin 2008

- Steering Committee and Technical Advisory guided
 - Three community-based pilot projects included
- Goals were to inform, encourage understanding, signal issues, & motivate discussion, decision-making & collective action
 - Provided Basin-wide report, web-based links and user support

- Search and compare indicators by community and corridor
- Mixed method, quantitative and qualitative methodologies
- Focus on indicators that can inform decision-making
- Long term focus on communitybased research






State of the Basin 2008 Framework


